



Memorandum of Understanding Between Dubai and the Tokyo Metropolitan Government

The Tokyo Metropolitan and the Government of Dubai, endeavoring to strengthen and further deepen the cooperative relations built to date and to make this relationship beneficial to the residents of both Tokyo and Dubai have agreed to engage in practical exchange and cooperation in the following areas.

1. Infrastructure and Transportation
2. Culture and Entertainment
3. Industry and Startups
4. Education
5. Disaster Preparedness and Urban Resilience
6. Digital

Both cities designate the International Affairs Division, Office of the Governor for Policy Planning, Tokyo Metropolitan Government, and the General Secretariat of The Executive Council of Dubai, in exercising its function and powers as a local authority, as the departments responsible for facilitating execution of this Memorandum of Understanding, and shall endeavor to steadily promote exchange and cooperation in these agreed areas.

The aforementioned responsible departments shall provide support to their city's departments charged with implementing policies in each of the areas covered by this Memorandum of Understanding.

This Memorandum of Understanding has been made in English. Both cities shall hold one copy of each text.
