1 Project name

Talents Tokyo 2020

2 Aim

The project aims to develop talents with the potential to become the "next masters", strengthening Tokyo's cultural output in the film industry. Gathering together aspiring young Asian directors and producers, the project provides lectures and advice from film experts who are currently working in the industry, so that participants can be exposed to perspectives of leading figures and be inspired by their experiences. The project also aims to introduce participants to an international network comprised of fellow participants and experts.

7 Program details

(1) About the program:

The 12-15 selected talents will participate in the following activities

Viewing sample films

Lectures and masterclasses (taught by experts)

Joint assessment of participants' projects by experts

Project presentation:

Each participant will present a project plan for a film they would like to make. Four main

experts (affiliated with the Berlinale Talents) and other local industry professionals will then analyze its various aspects, such as directing, producing and investment viability. The four main experts will discuss the various projects and choose one as the winner of the Talents Tokyo Award.

(2) Post-completion report

Within 3 weeks of completing the program, participants must submit a report. After submitting the report, they will be certified as having completed the program, and will receive a diploma in February 2021.

(3) Printed documents

The organizers will print information such as the talents' bios and projects and distribute them to other talents and people associated with the program.

8 Application requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- 1) You have an East-Asian / Southeast-Asian nationality or reside in those regions. You are fluent in the English language. You can submit a complete and accurate application online entirely in English and understand the application process.
- 2) You can take part remotely in all aspects of the program online.
- 3) You are willing to take part in the program in English.
- 4) You are an aspiring director/producer.

Directors: You should either (a) have studied or be studying film at a university or vocational school, and have directed at least one short/feature film or (b) have experience working on a film set as a director, and have directed at least one short/feature film.

Producers: You should have produced at least one short/feature film.

* Candidates who have not experienced film production as a professional are preferred, but all candidates who meet the above criteria will be considered regardless of their professional background.

Directors: A completed application form, a short film you have made (up to 15 minutes long), and a treatment for a film project you would like to develop (in English, up to 5 pages A4)

Producers: A completed application form, a comprehensive report of films you have produced so far (in English), and a treatment for a film project you would like to develop (in English, up to 5 pages A4)
