About “Shinjuku Neon Walk”

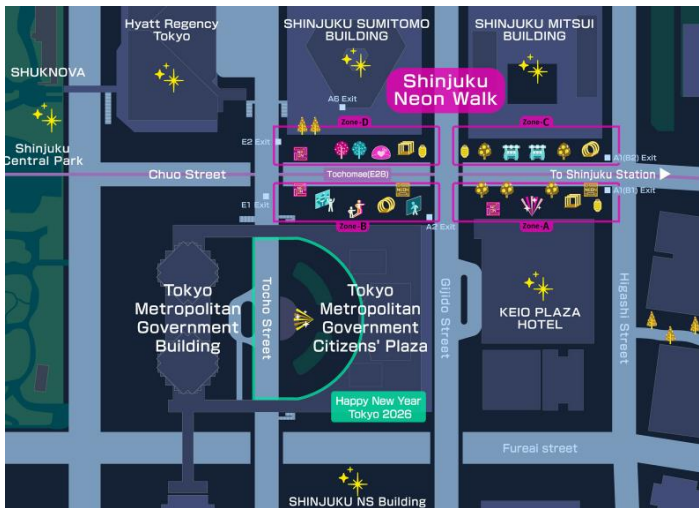
In Tokyo—a city where centuries-old traditions from the Edo period blend seamlessly with diverse modern cultures—a one-of-a-kind art illumination event will light up Nishi-Shinjuku. Spanning four zones along Chuo-dori Avenue, the event will feature a variety of light art installations, including AI-powered works by artist Daito Manabe and others. Visitors can immerse themselves in the enchanting glow of Tokyo’s illuminated nights.

Art Illumination

Event Dates: Thursday, November 27, 2025 – Wednesday, January 7, 2026, 16:30 - 22:00 (JST)

Event Location: Pedestrian area of Chuo-dori Avenue

Note: On Thursday, November 27, the illumination will begin at approximately 17:30, and on Wednesday, December 31, the event will extend until 25:00 (1:00 AM JST).

Neo NEON YATAI (Food Stalls)

Food stalls will offer gourmet experiences inspired by Edo-period culture, including sushi and other local dishes connected to Tokyo and Shinjuku.

Dates: Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from Thursday, November 27, 2025, to Sunday, December 28, 2025

Opening Hours: 17:00 - 22:00 (JST)

Notes:

- Food stalls will also be open on Thursday, November 27, Wednesday, December 24, Thursday, December 25, and Wednesday, December 31
- On Wednesday, November 27, hours will be open 17:45 - 22:00 (JST)
- On Wednesday, December 31, hours will be extended to 17:00 - 25:00 (1:00 AM JST)

Digital Stamp Rally

A digital stamp rally will be held, inviting participants to explore illuminated spots across the Shinjuku area using an interactive digital map.

Dates: Thursday, November 27, 2025 – Wednesday, January 7, 2026

Locations: 10 illumination spots around the Shinjuku area

How to Participate: Register via smartphone (no app installation required).

Prizes: Rewards will be given based on the number of stamps collected.

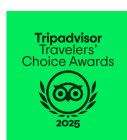
