



Memorandum of Understanding
Between
The City of Los Angeles and the Tokyo Metropolitan Government

The Tokyo Metropolitan Government and the City of Los Angeles, as host cities for the 2020 and 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games, respectively, have agreed to cooperate and engage in exchanges in the following areas of mutual interest, in order to develop the relationship between the two cities in a creative and practical manner that will benefit their residents.

- (1) Olympic and Paralympic Games
- (2) Sustainability
- (3) Resilience
- (4) Ports and harbors

Both cities designate the International Affairs Division, Office of the Governor for Policy Planning, Tokyo Metropolitan Government, and the Mayor's Office for International Affairs of the City of Los Angeles, as the departments responsible for the steady promotion of exchange and cooperation in these agreed areas.

The two cities shall regularly visit each other and hold discussions to further deepen their friendly and cooperative relationship.

The two cities may also exchange relevant staff members.

This Memorandum has been made in duplicate in English and Japanese, both equally authentic. Both cities shall hold one copy of each text.
